## **SAINTS OF THE WEEK:**

**Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> October: St Ignatius of Antioch (d.107) Martyr** Ignatius was second or third Bishop of Antioch, a see founded by St Peter. Nothing is known about him apart from his journey under arrest from Antioch to Rome where he was martyred. It was a slow progress and during it he wrote a number of letters to various Churches. These letters reveal a man passionately devoted to Christ who insists on both the Divinity and Humanity of Christ, the Eucharist as a continuation of Christ's life and the importance of Bishops for the unity of the Church.

Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> October: St Luke Author of both a Gospel and The Acts of the Apostles (very early history of the emerging Church). His gospel is noted for its many references to the women in Christ's life. He worked for a time with St Paul on some of his missions. Patron Saint of butchers, bookbinders, doctors, surveyors, artists and glassworkers.
