SAINTS OF THE WEEK: 1st March – St David (6th Cent.) Patron St of Wales Although he is one of the most famous of British Saints, little is known of him with any certainty rather than based on later legends. The more reliable of those tell us that he came from a noble family in Wales, became a Priest and then lived for a time in seclusion. A man of great austerity, he is said to have founded twelve monasteries before finally settling at Menevia (now St David's) where he was Bishop founding a house there on the lines of the strictest code of Egyptian monks. The symbol of the Welsh leek is supposed to have come about because David advised the Welsh warriors about to go into battle against the Anglo-Saxons to wear one to distinguish them from their enemies.
